

Abstract Submission Guidelines - HET Congress 2026

Submissions are open from **June 1st to September 30th, 2026**. Abstracts received after the deadline will not be considered.

Abstracts must be submitted in English as a single .pdf file to Het.congres@inserm.fr.

Format requirements:

The submitted file should include the following elements, in order:

- 1. Title:** Concise and informative, reflecting the main findings of the study.
- 2. Authors and affiliations:** List all contributing authors with their institutional affiliations. The presenting author should be underlined.
- 3. Theme selection:** Authors must select one or two themes from the list below:
 1. Mechanisms of liver regeneration and senescence
 2. Liver metabolism
 3. Predisposition, rare diseases
 4. Liver immunology and inflammatory response
 5. Oncogenesis and tumor heterogeneity
 6. Inter-organ crosstalk
- 4. Presentation preference:** Please indicate your preferred format: oral presentation, poster presentation, or both. Final assignment will be determined by the scientific committee based on reviewer evaluation.
- 5. Abstract body:** Maximum 250 words. The abstract should be structured to clearly present the background, aims, methods, results, and conclusions of the study.
- 6. Figure (optional):** A single figure may be included. If provided, the figure should be embedded within the document and accompanied by a brief legend. The figure and its legend are not counted toward the 250-word limit.

General instructions:

- Abstracts exceeding the 250-word limit will not be considered.
- Notification of acceptance and presentation format will be communicated after review by the scientific committee.
